Here's what you need to know:

Reporting - Equity Variety Officer Meeting:

On 12th July 2023, all Equity Branch Variety Officers were invited to attend a Zoom meeting with the unions Variety Organiser Michael Day to discuss the role whose primary purpose is to ensure variety-related topics are included in branch meetings' agendas and relevant guest speakers are invited to speak.

The Variety Officer is a reserved role in the committee of regional branches. This meeting provided essential clarity to our interim Variety Office Andy Storm on the role and its responsibilities.

The Role of the Variety Officer was outlined as follows:

- 1. Organise variety events.
- 2. Establish a local variety network (if requested by the branch).
- 3. Co-ordinate the branch's variety work.

Communications between Variety Officers:

To foster better communication, a WhatsApp group exclusively for Variety Officers has been set up.

Setting up a Variety Network:

At East Midlands Branch committee and previous members meetings an awareness of how little we know about the broader industry across the region for opportunities to network and secure work has become clear. Mapping the industry and finding fellow members in relevant sectors is vital and where better to start than Variety.

Registering to attend meetings helps with this. When signing up attendees are asked a couple questions. We ask for Membership No# and Postcode and now we are asking about industry sectors. With this information we can better understand the membership's professional focus and geographic presence.
